

Dallow & Co: " Were succeeded by Dick & Nelson. This latter firm, after running for some time in connection with Darnard & Co (F. L. Bernard) was finally bought out by that concern. In 1872 Darnard & Co, sold out to Wells, Fargo & Co.

" The route controlled by these expresses seems to have extended throughout the British Columbian settlements, and in various advertisements, I find mention of offices at Big Bend (Columbia River) Cariboo, and the Northern Mines, Yale, Linton, Lillooet, Arnton, Savonia Ferry, Auesnelle, or Auesnellemouth, Parkersville, Seymour and Drench Creek.
