

p. 37. In Feb'y 1855 Ad & Co established their office in S. Lake City with Felix Tracy as Agent. The route of this Express was from S. Fr. to Los Angeles by Boat thence by stage over the same route traversed by the present Un. Pacific Rly, passing San Bernardino, Las Vegas, Cedar City, American Fork, Nephi, Parowan, Fillmore City, Salt Creek, Payson's, Palmyra, Spanish Fork, Springfield, Provo, Battle Creek, Dry Creek, Crest Salt Lake, Farrington, Ogden and Box Elder. (Alta Feb'y 16, 1855 and Dec. 31, 1855).
