Warps from the Way - Bills of an Old Express man by  
T. W. Tucker - Boston 1872 - 143 pages. Carries express & local  
business as far back as 1811 in the days of the old Burrell line  
of Salem and Boston stages.

Stinson's "Express History" by A. L. Stinson, first published in  
1860, but rewritten, enlarged & published in 1881 as a subscription  
work only by the author and printed by Baker & Godwin  
N. Y. City. A most comprehensive work of ab. 400 pages covering  
the field of express history from the time of its origin in 1839  
down to the date of publication.
